Parking

All on-campus parking requires a valid ODU parking permit or faculty parking payment. ODU utilizes a virtual permit system and License Plate Recognition (LPR) to enforce parking rules.

Student Parking

Freshman and upperclassmen alike are all required to purchase a parking permit in order to park a vehicle on campus. ODU Commuter and Resident Student Semester Permits can be purchased online at odu.edu/parking. Monthly, Weekly, & Daily permit options are also available. See front of map for the QR code to parking lot maps for each permit type.

Faculty/Staff

Faculty/Staff Permits are renewed annually. You can renew and purchase online at odu.edu/parking. Monthly, Weekly, & Daily permit options are also available. See our website for Faculty/Staff parking locations.

Short Term Parking

Daily, Weekly, & Monthly Permits are available to anyone parking on campus and are valid in any Faculty/Staff, Commuter, or Resident location and can be purchased online at odu.edu/parking.

ADA Accessible Parking

Accessible parking spaces are reserved for individuals with disabilities. State-issued accessible parking placards must be accompanied by our valid ODU parking permit or hourly parking pass.

Citations & Appeals

Citations will be issued for violations of ODU's Rules & Regulations (available online at odu.edu/parking). Appeals: **MUST** be submitted within 10 business days of citation issue.

Appeals are reviewed by a committee before the second appeal is reviewed by a committee. Booting & towing vehicles with no permit or expired permit may be booted and/or towed at owner's expense.

Motorcycle/Moped Parking

Two-wheeled motor vehicles require a permit and must be parked in the designated space and signed in garages and parking lots. Motorcycle/Moped permits are available at the bicycle rack. Permits can be purchased at the TPS Office. All garages have Motorcycle & Moped parking areas.

Hourly & Daily Parking

After parking your vehicle, you must immediately use Monday through Friday, 8:00am - 5:00pm, on your mobile device or via pay station. To use the pay station, you must follow the prompts on the screen to enter your license plate number and payment information. Pay stations are located at the following locations:

- All VBHEC lots
- 45th St. & E. Kirkwood
- Central Coastland Center 45th & 45th St. Garages
- 49th St. Stadium Garage

Event Parking/Transportation

For an event or activity, you can request a parking/transportation request form online at odu.edu/parking. Reservations must be made at least 1 week in advance.

Transportation

Monarch Transit SafeRide

Transportation & Parking Services offers transportation to on-campus destinations with Monarch Transit Shuttles. ODU ID is required to board SafeRide.

SafeRide

With SafeRide you can request a ride home at night instead of walking. Routes are available between Magnolia Ave (North) and 38th Street (South), as well as the Elizabeth River (West) and Long Ave (East). ODU ID is required to board SafeRide.

Transloc App

Download the Transloc App to track Monarch Transit Shuttles in real time and request a SafeRide van. Rides for SafeRide MUST be requested through the Transloc App.

FREE Bike registration is available at ODU with Project 529. Go to project529.com/odu or download the Project 529 mobile App to register your bike. After registration, please come to the TPS Office with proof of registration to receive your free shield decal and U-locks.

Transportation & Parking Services offers Monarch Transit public transit and GoPass365 passes valid on all buses, light rail, and ferries. Passes can be purchased at the ODU ID Office with an ODU ID.

You can pick up or drop off Lime products at any bike rack or out of the right of way on the sidewalk.
