

### CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE

The cumulative grade point average (GPA) is determined by dividing the total grade points earned by the total credit hours attempted. The example below, based on a single semester, illustrates that 34 divided by 13 equals a GPA of 2.62. (GPA's are truncated, NOT rounded.) All grades received during a student's enrollment (including the grades of W, P, Z, and F in a Pass/Fail course) are included in the cumulative GPA. Grades received at other colleges are excluded.
